Itinerary / Tour Plan:

DAY 01: ARRIVAL IN JODHPUR

On this day, you will receive from Udaipur Railway Station and transferred to hotel. proceed towards Jodhpur, Upon arrival check in to the hotel, visit Jodhpur top attractions like the **Mehrangarh Fort**, an imposing colossal fort that stands on a rocky hill at a height of 400 metres above the city level. Latticed windows, beautifully-carved panels and elaborately-decorated walls enhance the beauty of this fort. You can get insight into the rich heritage of the city at its museum that showcases musical instruments, palanquins, royal costumes, furniture, and arms and armour.. Within the fort, visit **Moti Mahal and Phool Mahal**. Also visit **Ghanta Garh, Jaswant Thada** an imposing marble cenotaph, built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant singh II around 1899 and **Umaid Public gardens**. Overnight stay at the hotel in Jodhpur .



DAY 02: JODHPUR – JAISALMER (300 KM/ 5-6 H)

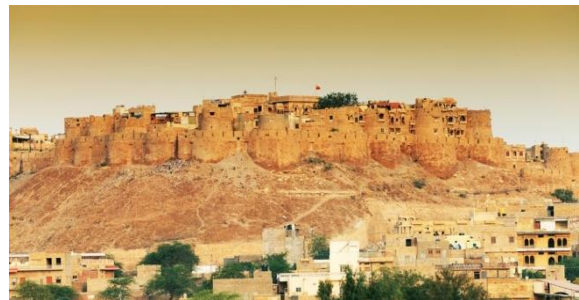


In Morning after Breakfast, you would be taken for a long drive to Jaisalmer which is around 8 hours away from Jodhpur. It is a city which marvels beautiful culture and it is one of the

most exotic place. The narrow streets of the old town conceal magnificent havelis, all carved from the golden-honey sandstone? hence Jaisalmer is also known as the **Golden City**, Arrive Jaisalmer at the evening check-in to the Camp. By the evening go for a unique experience of the Desert alike Arabian night by making overnight stays over **Sand dunes** with tented accommodation with cultural program and also enjoy photogenic sunset on camel back. **Dinner** & Overnight at Desert Camp

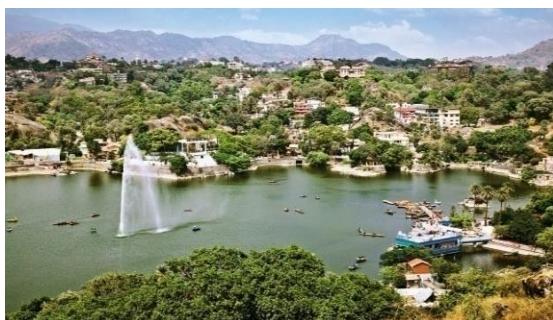
DAY 03: JAISALMER – LOCAL SIGHTS – HUNTED VILLAGE

In Morning after Breakfast, Check out to the camp and proceed towards Jaisalmer city En route visit **Kuldhara Village**, is a cursed village of Paliwal Brahmins, who abandoned this place 200 years ago due to unknown reasons. This abandoned **village** in Jaisalmer is one of the most popular tourist attractions of *Jaisalmer*.



Later proceed to local sight seen Explore the magnificence of **Jaisalmer Fort, the golden fortress constructed by the renowned Rajput ruler Jaisal in 1156, is located at the majestic Trikuta hills.** It is also known as **Sonar Kila**. Its historical importance stands with the many battles fought in this spectacular Fort. Afterwards visit **Bada Bagh and Vyas Chhatris. (80 meters above plains) Nathmalji-Ki-Haveli and Patwaon ki Haveli, Jaisalmer war museum, Gadisar Lake**, In evening back to hotel. Comfortable Overnight stay at hotel in Jaisalmer

DAY 04: JAISALMER – MOUNT ABU (450 KM / 8-9 H)



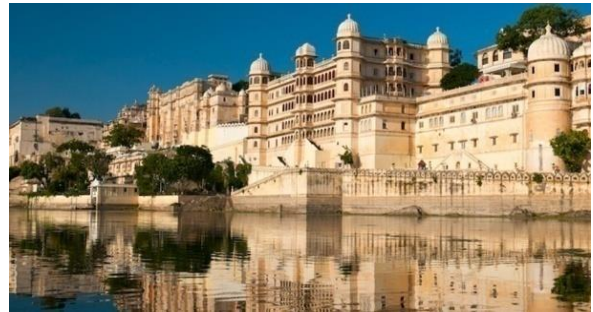
After breakfast, proceed towards Mount Abu- is the beautiful journey passing through Aravali Mountain and in the womb of the nature. The only hill station of Rajasthan with pleasant temperature round the year, Arrive check in to the hotel, visit Jain Dilwara Temples that are world famous for their stunning use of marbles. Prajapita Brahmakumari- from of Raja Yoga is where they say the knowledge disseminated,

Guru Shikhar-is the highest point in Rajasthan and is home to the temple of Dattatreya, an

incarnation of Lord Vishnu. Honeymoon Point- is an attractive point for the visitors for it being in the natural, In evening enjoy boat ride at popular Nakki Lake (At your own). In evening return back to the hotel, Overnight stay at hotel in Mount abu.

DAY 05: MOUNT ABU – UDAIPUR (160 KM / 2-3 H)

After breakfast, proceed towards Udaipur transferred to hotel. Check-in to the hotel, after some leisure drive out for, **Udaipur: formally known as the city of lakes.** Udaipur, the capital of the former princely state of Mewar is a beautiful city in Rajasthan, India. Udaipur is also referred to as the "**Venice of the East**" 'the city of lakes' is admired for its fairy-tale palaces, lakes, temples, and gardens among many more. If time permit visit **Vintage Car Museum, Gulab Bagh and nearby palace,** In evening you can enjoy the boating at **Pichola Lake** (At your own cost), In evening return back to hotel, Overnight stay at hotel in Udaipur.



DAY 06: UDAIPUR – LOCAL SIGHTSEEN



In Morning after Breakfast, proceed for full day sightseeing tour of Udaipur. Built in 1559 A.D. by Maharaja Udai Singh, the city has been described as the most romantic spot on the continent of India by Col. James Todd. The places of interest include **City Palace** - one of the largest palaces in Rajasthan, The palace was originally built by Maharana Udai Singh, and has been featured in many Indian and international films. The museum on the premises is also a remarkable visit as it tries to preserve the history of the people of Mewar and Udaipur, Which has several carved balconies, arches and decorated pillars, **Zenana Mahal, Durbar Hall and Shambhu Niwas.** Also visit **Jagdish temple, Bhartiya Lok Kala Mandir (Folk art museum), Sahelion-ki-Bari** (queen's resort for the friends). visit **Bagore ki Haveli.** This gracious architectural marvel takes you directly to the Rajputana period as here you can trace the classic and exclusive

royal stuff ranging from their jewellery to copper vessels. The grand haveli presents a perfect atmospheric setting to enjoy the traditional Rajasthani folk dance and music. It is a perfect place to witness the royal lifestyle from the bygone era. In evening return back to hotel, Overnight stay at hotel in Udaipur.

DAY 07: UDAIPUR – CHITTORGARH – DAY TRIP

In morning after breakfast, proceed for Chittorgarh, upon reaching check in to the hotel, **Chittorgarh** is the epitome of Rajput (Warrior caste) pride, romance and spirit, for people of Chittor always chose death before surrendering against anyone. The major attraction here is the massive hilltop fort that is a symbol of all that was brave, true and noble in the glorious Rajput tradition. The Chittorgarh Fort seated on a 180-metre-high hill, covers an expanse of 700



acres and rises rapidly from the plains. Fiercely independent, the fort was under siege thrice and each time they fought bravely and thrice Jauhar (massive suicide) was committed by the ladies and children, first led by Rani Padmini, and later by Rani Karnavati. After visiting the fort explore **Victory Tower** (the Vijay Stambh) and the picturesque **Padmini Palace**. In evening return back to hotel, Overnight stay at hotel in Udaipur.

DAY 08: UDAIPUR– ABU ROAD (DEPARTURE)

In Morning after Breakfast check out to the hotel and proceed towards Abu Road Railway Station, for your onward journey to your next destination. Tour ends with sweet Memories with “**Look My Rajasthan.com**”
